

PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO 4 YEAR INTEGRATED B.A. / B.Sc. B.Ed.

1. 1. Application Process

The application form is available at www.fmcollege.nic.in. An applicant can download the form and take a print-out. The form has to be filled in all respects and the same has to be sent to fmcollegebeddepartment2015@gmail.com in the PDF format.

1. 2. Documents Required

- i) Mark Sheet and Certificate of HSC or equivalent examination.
- ii) Mark Sheet and Certificate of CHSE or equivalent examination.
- iii) Caste Certificate, where reservation is claimed.

An applicant is required to scan all the relevant certificates, convert them to the PDF format and attach the same with the application form.

1. 3. Fees

A sum of Rs.500/- as application fee has to be deposited in the Account No - 50200047026807, IFSC Code - HDFC0005340. The acknowledgement receipt generated has to be scanned, converted to PDF and attached with the application form and necessary documents.

Application received without the deposit slip will be summarily rejected. The applicants are advised to not visit the college for any enquiry. They can contact the Admission-in-Charge for assistance, if necessary.

1. 3. 1. Course Fee

The course fee of the programme is 40,000/- per annum. A candidate, selected to take admission, has to deposit the 1st instalment of 40,000/- in the stipulated account of the college. This is in addition to the college and the examination fees as decided in accordance with College/ University fee structure.

A student desirous of taking his/ her CLC at any time after the normal admission process is over has to pay the full course fee of Rs.1,60,000/- before the CLC can be issued. The other fees deposited at the time of admission or readmission will also be forfeited.

2. 1. Principles of Selection

- a) For admission to B.A. B.Ed. a candidate must i) have passed +2 Arts/Commerce/Science with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate; or
ii) have passed +3 Degree Examination in Arts with at least 50% in the aggregate;
- b) For admission to B.Sc. B.Ed. (PCM) a candidate must have passed +2 science with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate with the subject combination of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at the +2 level;
- c) For admission to B.Sc. B.Ed. (CBZ) a candidate must have passed +2 science with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate with the subject combination of Biology, Physics and Chemistry at the +2 level;

An applicant desirous of applying for both the streams have to use separate application forms and have to pay fees separately.

d) Admission to the stream shall be done strictly on the basis of merit. Marks secured at the 10th and the +2 (Higher Secondary) levels will be taken into consideration for preparing the merit list for admission to a stream.

- i) 50% of marks secured at the 10th level will be added to
- ii) 100% of marks secured at the +2 level

to arrive at the final marks secured by an applicant.

For example, a girl securing 300 out of 600 at the HSC and 300 out of 600 at the +2 level will have a score of $150+300=450$.

The base marks for both the levels will be 600 each and students passing from Boards other than BSE and CHSE will have their marks calculated out of 600. There will be no selection of best 4 or best 5.

2. 2. Selection of core and elective subjects

a) After selection of the stream, a student has to choose a core subject. The college offers core teaching in the following subjects with 10 seats each.

English, Odia, History, Political Science, Geography, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Mathematics.

For admission to a particular core course, the merit list prepared earlier will be used.

2. 3. A student pursuing B.A B.Ed. must have the following electives

Elective 1/2 - English/ Odia

Elective 2/1 - History/ Geography/ Economics/ Political Science

3. Intimation

The list of applicants, found eligible for admission, will be available on the college website. The individual applicant can download the intimation letter from the same site and then proceed in accordance with directions printed therein.

4. Admission procedure

The applicants have to be physically present in the college on dates mentioned in the Intimation letter to take admission. They must bring the following documents in the original along with their photocopies.

- i) HSC or Equivalent Certificate
- ii) HSC or Equivalent Mark Sheet
- iii) Higher Secondary or Equivalent Certificate
- iv) Higher Secondary or Equivalent Mark Sheet
- v) a) Caste/ Tribe Certificate, if any, from revenue officer not below the rank of Additional Tehsildar
- b) PWD Certificate from CDMO/SDMO/CMO of capital Hospital, BBSR.
- c) Ex-Serviceman Certificate from Zilla/ Rajya Sainik Board.
- d) SDP (Army/ Navy/ Air Force) Certificate from the Commanding Officer of the Unit
- e) CoM Certificate from the District Collector.

- vi) SLC/ CLC and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended
- vii) Migration Certificate for applicants passing from Boards other than CHSE, Odisha
- viii) 3 Passport size recent colour photos
- ix) Deposit slip for course fee and other fees.

5. Reservation

- a) SC - 16.25%
- b) ST - 22.5%

The reserved seats are not interchangeable between SC and ST

- c) SC/ST applicants selected for admission on their merit shall not be counted against reserved seats.
- d) However, any modification made by the Government on the reservation policy will be followed during admission.
- e) PWD - 5%
- f) ESM/ SDP/ Com - 1%
