

THE FLAG

The colours of the Coat of Arms are gold in the first quarter, silver in the second and third quarters and azure in the fourth quarter. On 6th July 2019, on the occasion of inaugural ceremony of the Platinum Jubilee the college unfurled its own flag for the first time. The Flag is horizontal, Rectangular and white with the coat of arms in the middle. The size of the flag is in proportion of three 3:2. It has been decided to fly the flag atop the British Hall throughout the year day and night except on the Republic Day and the Independence Day when the Tricolor has to be flown high.

THE ANTHEM

On the same day the college also released its own anthem. The Anthem, paean to this temple of learning, is to be played at the commencement of all official functions of the college. All present have to stand up as the mark of respect.

The Anthem is composed in Odia, its Latin transliteration is as follows:
